The 4th African Dairy Conference and Exhibition will take place in Nairobi, Kenya from 6 to 8 August this year.

Initially the conference was supposed to be held in June. It has since been pushed to August to make room for the stabilisation of the current political disturbances being experienced in the host country.

This year's theme is "African Dairy: Regional Integration – The Key to Growth". The conference is set to offer a great opportunity for regional and international dairy stakeholders to interact with experts, practitioners, investors, researchers and policy makers in the dairy industry.

This year's event is expected to attract more than 300 professionals from all sectors of the dairy industry and will offer attendees an unmatched opportunity to meet, network and share the latest information on the dairy industry. The event will be graced by regional

and international speakers who will be talking about the current dairy world situation, dairy policy and trade, technology, marketing, smallholders and commercialisation.

Also to be discussed is a revisitation of the place that milk and milk products have in nutrition, the environment and food quality.
